When the best hope for recovery lies with a cancer center far from home, the American Cancer Society Hope Lodge in Marshfield provides a comfortable, nurturing environment – a "home away from home" – where patients and families can stay during treatments, free of charge. Hope Lodge is conveniently located, a short walk from nationally accredited Marshfield Clinic and Marshfield Medical Center providing support to patients and caregivers when they need it most.

Cancer treatments are long and complex, and often require the patient to remain close to the cancer center for prolonged periods of time. In the past, this often required an expensive stay at a local hotel. The American Cancer Society Hope Lodge Marshfield provides lodging free of charge, in an environment that provides support from other patients, caregivers, and staff at Hope Lodge – a community that helps ease the burden of a cancer diagnosis.

Since the American Cancer Society Hope Lodge Marshfield opened in 2003, we have served nearly 28,600 guests and provided almost 74,000 overnight stays, saving our patients and their families an estimated \$12 million. All funds raised at the 11<sup>th</sup> annual Vita Bella Gala will directly support the American Cancer Society Hope Lodge Marshfield, ensuring our ability to provide this benefit to our cancer patients and their families.
